Monthly Summary

- Index performance shows a significant increase in market sentiments, where ASPI gained by 1,943.77 points, S&P SL 20 gained by 595.95 points and AWLI gained by 54.99 points.
- Previous month turnover of LKR 29.27 Bn has increased by an immense amount up to the value of LKR 73.10 Bn.
- Foreign inflows were led by JKH.N and outflow were led by SUN.N, while recording a net foreign inflow for the month ended with a value of LKR 2.23 Bn.
- Top gainers list was led by RGEM.N with 149.04% gain and top losers were led by MAL.N -14.24% with a thin turnover.
- Multiple crossings took place during the week where AGAL.N was the highest among them with a crossing value of LKR 4.6 Bn.
- Several dealings by directors were noted during the month.
- Monthly tea price movements showed a general up trend and the volumes showed an increase for the month as well except for the high grown.
- T bill rates have depicted a significant decline, whereas the standing deposit facility rate and standing lending facility rate also showed a decline.
- Monthly AWPR has declined by 221 points (2.21%) to 16.96% form the previous month
- The Global Commodity market has shown an increase in metal and gas prices, notably, crude oil was up by 20.21% and Brent oil was up by 17.05% compared to the previous month.
- International markets also showed a general up trend in market sentiments, where Bursa Malaysia recorded the highest positive increment of 3.68%.





ASPI Index Chart




S&P SL 20 Index Chart










Net Foreign Inflow (Yearly/Monthly) Net Foreign Inflow (Yearly)




Net Foreign Inflow (Monthly)




